20 YEARS OF INPACT

2013

In August of 2013, we opened our premier program "Kingdom Kare Childcare Center" with the mission to love children "God's way". Our childcare center became a success through our core values of "LOVE". In this program, we serve families with children birth to school aged.

2014

In June of 2014, we began our annual "Summer Camp" program. With this program, it is our desire to provide a safe, engaging, fun-filled environment for students while schools are not in session. Learning doesn't stop on summer break! At our summer camp, students are exposed to various skills and arts by professional consultants in sewing, media, martial arts, and other enrichment activities.







2016

In September of 2016, we embarked on another empowering journey with our *Mentoring* program. This program was specifically created with partnering school in Anne Arundel County to support youth in the areas of anger management, conflict resolution, suicide prevention, bullying, goal setting, time management, stress reduction, teamwork, and self-esteem building. Equipping youth with training and soft skills to be prepared for success in life and adulthood is close to the heart of Kingdom Kare, Inc.

2019

In January of 2019, we saw a great need in our community for food security. In response to this need we created our "Food Distribution" program which consists of weekly food drives and food pantries. In this program we are able to help an average of 1500 individuals each week who now all have access to produce, dairy, dry goods, canned goods, various proteins, bread, and more.



2020

In August of 2020, in response to the Covid-19 pandemic, we saw a great need for students to be able to attend a safe and familiar learning environment while not being able to attend school in-person. To meet this need, we launched our "Remote Learning" program that served 200 students. In this program students were able to socialize in a safe way, learn with the assistance of our teaching staff and were provided two prepared meals a day in addition to snack time.

2021

In August of 2021 we opened our "Family Support Center". This resource center is a lifelong dream for our President and CEO, Dr. Barbara Palmer. The overall goal and mission of our family support center is to provide prevention-oriented programs and wrap around services to strengthen families in our community and surrounding areas of the county. Our main program in the Family Support Center is our "TPEP" (Teen Parent Educational Program) where we host up to 20 teen mothers onsite with education and other supplemental programming to help them attain their high school diplomas.

2022

In July of 2022 we launched our "Violence Interuption and Prevention Program" (VIPP). This program is comprised of change agents who engage and educate our surrounding communites on the importance of promoting peace and non-violence. This program also facilitates a Violence Interruption Hotline to mediate and intervene in potentially violent incidents. "Peace is the better way every day!"



Kingdom Kare Childcare center is a nationally accredited, licensed childcare center committed to "caring for your child God's way." We serve families with children birth to 5-years-old, along with a before and after school care component for school age children.

FAMILY SUPPORT

Kingdom Kare Family Support Center provides wrap around, prevention-oriented services for teen parents striving to obtain their High School diplomas. Our programming is designed with resources to empower our clients to thrive regardless of what obstacles are presented to them.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION

The goal of our Food Distribution programming is to address the increasing need for food security in our community. We provide fresh produce, dairy, protein, dry goods, canned goods, breads, eggs and more with no "requirements".

MENTORING

"The Plug" program targets middle and high school student to equip the youth of our community with life skills in the areas of anger management, suicide prevention, drug use prevention, goal setting, stress reduction, team work, self-esteem building, work force development, violence interruption and more.

VIOLENCE INTERRUPTION

Kingdom Kare's "VIPP" program uses community engagement to promote peace and non-violence in historically underserved communities. VIPP provides positive messaging, community peace rallies, conflict resolution training, a crisis intervention hotline and more.

VETERANS RESOURCES

COMING SOON, The KKI Veterans Resource Center of Excellence will provide a holistic approach to help vulnerable, displaced and homeless veterans towards the path of self-sufficiency. We will provide wraparound services including housing, case management, counseling, belief therapy, claims clinics, job placement and more.
